TRIP OVERVIEW

WHAT IS THE TRIP?

The class of 2024 plans to take a senior trip to conclude our time at the Museum School. **This will be a four day trip to New York City.** Students will have the opportunity to curate the trip to what they are interested in, choosing activities like visiting museums, seeing historical landmarks, attending Broadway shows, and exploring the city.

WHY NEW YORK?

It would also serve as a relationship building opportunity for students to take with them after graduation. **This trip will be the culmination of Museum School global and local education.**
